## \*\*\*\*\*Five Star Indoor Series\*\*\*\*\*

The CTAA in conjunction with local ranges and clubs has scheduled a five tournament series to be held at venues throughout the state. The CT State JOAD Championship and the CT State Indoor Championship will both be part of these events.

A series Grand Champion will be declared after the final tournament in February. In order to qualify for the Grand Champion trophy, archers must participate in at least 4 of the 5 tournaments. Archers who participate in all 5 tournaments may drop their lowest score. Grand Champions will be declared in every division which averages at least 3 participates per event.

Tournaments will be held as follows:

October 8 & 9 – Hall’s Arrow – Manchester

November 12 – UCONN – Hawley Armory Storrs

December 10 & 11 – Harwinton Rod and Gun- Harwinton - CT STATE JOAD CHAMPIONSHIP

January 14 & 15 – Algonquin Archers – Woodbury

February 18 & 19 – Hall’s Arrow – Manchester – CT STATE INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIP

Registration for entire series is \$100 per archer. Individual tournament registrations will be \$30 per archer per tournament. Any archer who is a member of USA Archery or NFAA may compete in the series and are eligible for the Grand Champion Trophies regardless of state of residence.

Awards for the CT State JOAD Championship and CT State Indoor Championship will be limited to CT Residents. There will be guest categories for both of these tournaments.

The 2016 CTAA JOAD Championship and the 2017 CTAA State Indoor Championship are both USA Archery registered Tournaments.

Each tournament is a FITA Round and consists of a 600 round (20 ends of 3 arrows each) with a two minute time period per end. All competitors will shoot their required target based on age or a regular 3 spot at 18 meters. Inner 10 ring will be in effect for the FITA compound divisions and classes. The outer 10 ring will be in effect for all classes in the FITA Olympic Recurve, Longbow, Traditional Recurve and FITA Barebow.

FITA Constitution and Rules and USA Archery Dress Code (NO CAMO or BLUE JEANS) will be strictly observed for all competitors.

Award ceremonies will be held at the conclusion of the final line on the final day of each tournament. The Grand Champion trophy presentations will follow the CT State Championship awards at Hall's Arrow On February 19, 2017.

Results will be posted on line as soon as possible.
